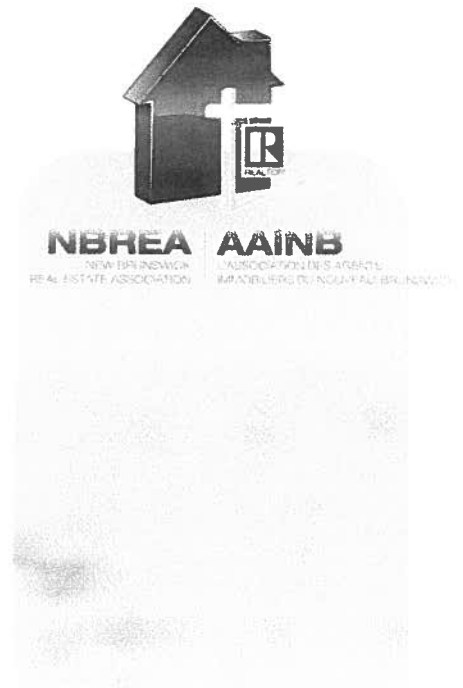

Policy NBREA-CE-002: Section D

Examination: Labour Reciprocity

Real Estate practitioners from other provinces may qualify for Labour Reciprocity in the Province of New Brunswick, providing they successfully meet the following criteria:

- I. Currently hold a valid license to trade in real estate in a jurisdiction within Canada – or; held a valid license to trade in real estate in a jurisdiction within Canada, during the previous 12 months.
- II. Receive NBREA acceptance regarding all education and sanction history from **each** of the jurisdictions where previous real estate licenses were issued. Education and sanction history must be supplied directly from the jurisdiction of origin in original document form (emails not accepted). Approval is valid for 3 months. If NBREA membership is not yet activated after 3 months, updated education and sanction history must be submitted.
- III. Successfully complete the NBREA Labour Reciprocity Course with a passing score of 75% on the final quiz. The quiz must be submitted by the candidate and approved by the Director of Education. 2018 Course fee is \$250 plus HST (\$287.50).
- IV. Candidates requesting manager status must also complete the Trust Account Administration course, as provided by the Director of Education. 2018 course fee is \$50 plus HST (\$57.50)
- V. Join NBREA as a member in good standing, having paid all relative fees.
- VI. Successfully obtain a real estate license from the Financial and Consumer Services Commission, in accordance with requirements prescribed by the Commission.
- VII. Complete the yearly Mandatory Continuing Professional Development requirements as set forth by the Committee of Examiners and confirmed by the Director of Education.
